### 2022 Boot Camp – Housing FAQs

The following list of housing Frequently Asked Questions has been compiled to assist you in planning your arrival to campus.

- 1. I have a housing contract with the UMKC Office of Residential Life; may I move in to my residence hall room during orientation for the Boot Camp?**  
Yes, you may. You may move into your assigned residence hall room on Sunday between 10:00am and 12:00pm, the day Boot Camp starts.
- 2. How do I request to move in early to the residence hall for the Boot Camp?**  
By default, if you indicate on your Boot Camp registration form that you have a housing contract, we will assume you will be moving in early. You may indicate on the registration form if you do not wish to move in early to your assigned residence hall room.
- 3. May I stay in the residence halls for the Boot Camp if I don't have an on-campus housing assignment for fall 2022?**  
No. Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate these requests due to staffing requirements. Students must have a completed residence hall contract submitted to the Residential Life Office in order to stay on campus during the SBC Boot Camp.
- 4. If I have a housing contract, where will I be staying during the Boot Camp?**  
All participants will reside in the residence hall they have been assigned to by the Residential Life Office. Those who will be residing in the Bio-Chem Living Learning Community (LLC) will be in Johnson Hall.
- 5. Where and when can I check in for housing for the Boot Camp?**  
You may check in to your residence hall on Sunday, the day Boot Camp starts, between 10:00am – 12:00pm. Please note that the housing check-in process is not the same as check-in for the actual Boot Camp program; please consult the [Boot Camp website](#) for more details on program check-in time and location.
- 6. Can I arrive for the Boot Camp earlier than Sunday at 10am?**  
Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate these requests due to staffing requirements.
- 7. Are housing charges included in the SBC Boot Camp cost?**  
No, housing charges are not included. Housing rates will be approximately \$145-\$155 for someone in a double room and \$190-\$200 for a single room for five days (Sunday-Thursday). The housing costs for the residence halls are approved by the Curators, so the price may change slightly. The additional housing costs for the Boot Camp will be charged directly to participating students via their student account. The residence hall is open for everyone the Friday of normal Move-In Day.

**8. What is the Bio-Chem Living Learning Community (LLC)?**

This is a reserved pod of rooms in Johnson Hall for Biology and Chemistry majors. The LLC will have special programming and activities tailored to the needs and interests of these students. This is an opportunity to meet and live with students who have similar interests and career goals.

**9. Does my attendance at the Boot Camp have an effect on my application or placement in the LLC?**

No, it does not. Application to live in the LLC in Johnson Hall is independent to your application to the Boot Camp.

**10. I will be living in the UMKC residence halls, but not in Johnson Hall. May I live in my fall assignment for the Boot Camp?**

Absolutely. You will automatically be placed in your fall assignment if you have a residence hall contract.

**11. I will be living on campus in the fall, but will not be staying on campus for the Boot Camp. When is the earliest I can check in to my fall assignment?**

You will not be permitted to check-in to your assignment until Move-In Day. The Move-In Day is dependent on your residence hall and your last name. Please refer to [Residential Life website](#) for more information.

**12. Can I leave my belongings in my room but not sleep in my room?**

Yes, you may. Please note that you will be subject to the same cost as described in question 7, above.

**13. How do I pay for my early arrival housing?**

The total cost will be placed on your student account. You will be charged after you move in on Sunday for Boot Camp.
