Student Achievement

The 2022 Fall Studio project “South Round Top Neighborhood Development and Resilience Plan” won the 2023 Outstanding Student Project Award from the Missouri Chapter of the American Planning Association. This studio, directed by Dr. Jacob Wagner, worked with the South Round Top Neighborhood Association with support from the UMKC Center for Neighborhoods, Hoxie Collective and the Kansas City LISC Office.

Students continue to show success in their required internships. External evaluation of students reveal high rates of achievement. Students worked in a variety of placements including the UMKC Center for Neighborhoods, a community improvement district, an international housing and planning agency, cities in greater Kansas City and private consulting firms in urban planning.
