## **School of Graduate Studies Plan of Study Guidelines:**

In consultation with a faculty advisor, the doctoral student develops a plan of study in accordance with the minimum requirements outlined in the SGS Academic Regulations and the specific degree program requirements. The student should initiate this application, secure the approvals indicated below for processing prior to completion of 50% of the hours applicable to the degree program, and submit the completed, signed form to their advisor.

- 300/400 level classes may be approved for graduate credit by petition to the Academic Unit.
- No more than 40 percent of the program may be 300- and 400-level courses.
- The total amount of graduate credit earned from all other academic institutions before admission to a UMKC doctoral program and applied to the doctoral degree cannot exceed half the number of credit hours, exclusive of dissertation research credits, required for the degree.
- **Grade Requirements:** No 300- or 400-level course with a grade below B- (2.7); and no 5000-level or higher course with a grade below C (2.0), will count toward any advanced degree program. Final GPA at the time the degree is conferred must be 3.0 or higher for all courses in the doctoral career.
