## COURSES TAUGHT

## ART + DESIGN CURRICULUM

2016 - 2020

**FOUN 100 – KCAI Foundation Studio I.**

*In the first semester studio course, students begin developing a vocabulary that is rooted in visual experience, learning to transcend literalism, link verbal and visual ideas and to experience the enjoyment of making and imagining. Students work with one instructor throughout the semester (16 weekly contact hours); this mentor will help students understand critique and self-reflection. Students encounter a range of creative challenges related to zones of perception, design forces, and dimensional form-making. These objective include drawing, design thinking, 3d form investigation, materiality and and time-based explorations. In addition to weekly studio objectives, students participate in orientations to wood fabrication technologies and digital photography for two hours each week.*

2017 - 2020

**FOUN 110 – KCAI Foundation Studio II.**

*The Foundation Department spring semester is divided into three sequenced, five-week workshops that focus on intellectual, imagistic, and process-based learning platforms. Unlike the fall curriculum, the spring semester asks students to design their individual paths of inquiry based on self-assessed needs and educational interests, or to rediscover a talent through new avenues. The Foundation faculty collaboratively design individual curriculum that varies each year and are often focused through process, materiality, specific content, or deeper explorations into a given discipline. Workshops Taught listed below.*

SPRING 2020

**WORKSHOP – Light Space Void**

*Is a study in materiality, and specifically focuses on the processes of mold-making, forming, and casting to create solid concrete sculptures. Daily course work explores how light and space interact with each other through the control and manipulation of surfaces and voids on architectonic concrete forms.*

SPRING 2020

**WORKSHOP – Articulate Frame Skin**

*This design/build workshop asks student to construct three monumental forms as part of an immersive installation: a canal, a gate, and a chamber. In collaboration with a studio constructing folded paper flora, sound works, and projections, these structures create a world that moves between organic growth and a mysterious underworld. The culmination of this course was a celebration engaging community members, patrons and students.*

SPRING 2020

**WORKSHOP – Micro Macro Model**

*In architecture the model is a method of visualizing. Micro Macro Model approaches three-dimensional design problems through intuitive building investigations using wood as the primary medium. Influences for these models include architecture, microscopic subjects, and organic life.*

SPRING 2019

**WORKSHOP – Spatial Drawing**

*Spatial Drawing explores the intersection between composition and form generation through the manipulation of spacial, linear sculptures rendered with soldered brass wire.*

SPRING 2019

**WORKSHOP – Casting Light**

*This course is a study in materiality, and specifically focuses on the processes of mold-making, forming, and casting of solid concrete sculptures. Expanding the inquiries into light and its imagistic potential, photographic responses made by documenting and mapping the cast forms creates new perceptual outcomes from similar departures.*

SPRING 2019

**WORKSHOP – Surface Image**

*The relationship between surface, plane and dimension form is the primary focus of this workshop. How images envelop, distinguish and fracture when seen as surface create opportunities to explore spatial dynamics, dimensional language, site-specific installations and their relationship to service-driven and expression-based practices.*

SPRING 2018

**WORKSHOP – Light Craft, Air Craft, Shaping Light**

*Using model airplanes, blimps, kites, and Japanese paper lanterns as points of departure to explore illuminated structures, students construct three-dimensional forms that examine the relationship between 3-D form and light. How students choose to shape the light is their greatest design challenge.*

*Focusing on three-dimensional model-making, this workshop focuses on designing, building, and exploring woodworking processes with an emphasis on the model being both a beginning and an end. Students were asked to think spatially, consider the power of abstract form, and develop an intuitive sense of form through making.*

SPRING 2017 **WORKSHOP – Urban Animals**  
*Urban Animals is a workshop focused on full-scale construction and re-configuration of furniture elements through the extensive use of woodworking processes and tools. Found objects and wooden furniture become transformed to express and respond to contextual conditions and research of anthropomorphic traits - further explore the form, place, meaning of functional structures.*

SPRING 2012 **ARCH 433 – Building Construction Systems in Architecture**  
*A lecture course that develops an understanding of how materials and systems assembly reinforce and extend the intentions of the designer as well as an understanding of the strategies and techniques for integration and coordination of the building components. For ARCH and IAPD students.*

WINTER 2007 **ARCH 765 – Problems in Architecture I - Architectural Competitions.**

SPRING 2007 **ARCH 404 – Architectural Design Studio IV.**  
*Emphasis is given to the relationship of architectural design within an urban environment, focusing on development of building programs as well as the syntheses of functional, technical, and aesthetic considerations within multi-story building environments. Focus is placed on the process of digital design and representation.*

SPRING 2007 **ARCH 710 – Seminar - The Art of Making.**  
*While the space of architecture is most often designed and perceived as lines on paper, it is through the making of physical models that the creative act of discovery reveals its greatest potential.*

FALL 2006 **ARCH 605 – Architectural Design Studio V.**  
*ADS V is the first studio taken by students after completing the “core” architecture curriculum during second and third years. The course, comprehensive in scope, with three objectives: to demonstrate a facility with the design skills learned in ADS I–IV; to show an ability to synthesize individual architectural intentions with structural, mechanical, lighting and movement systems; and to graphically present a proposed design using the norms of contract documentation.*

FALL 2006 **DSFN 201 – Environmental Design Studio I.**  
*Introduction to the environmental design professions of architecture, landscape architecture, interior architecture and interior design. Focus is given to basic design concepts, principles, processes, knowledge, and skills. Provides instruction in two dimensional, three dimensional, mechanical drawing, freehand drawing and model building to represent and communicate design ideas at different scales of observation and the implication of space.*
